RETREAT FOCUS: How can abiding in Christ transform your perspective as a coach when you come alongside others? We believe a Spirit-led coaching journey focuses helping others to Assess → Abide → Align → Advance.

Have you ever wondered what goes on behind the scenes to bring "the fruit of the vine" to you? How do the vinedresser, the grape vine, and its branches each contribute to the result?

Our desire is to "grow deeper in our dependence on Jesus and His Word – as individuals, in community, and on an organizational level – resulting in biblical fruitfulness." *Abide In Christ Foundational Bible Study* will serve as your guide for moving toward deeper abiding in Jesus, the foundation of igniting and multiplying as a disciple-maker.

### ROUND 1 - Value of Coaching in the Face of Uncertainty
